WARNING 4074 IN TERMS OF THE ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT NO. 71 OF 1962

In respect of the inspection at your farm today, herewith please find the concerns that were discussed with you.

1. All walkways within the barns and walkways leading to the milking parlour as well as the flooring of the parlour must be non-slip to prevent animals from slipping and being injured unnecessarily. This must be rectified by no later than 11 November 2022.
 2. All walkways within the barns and walkways leading to the milking parlour as well as the flooring of the parlour must be cleaned after each milking. This will further prevent animals from slipping and not be forced to stand in accumulated dung.
 3. All wet bedding must be removed and not just topped up with fresh bedding. This may also prevent the fly infestation and may help the fly repellent to actually work.
 4. All paddocks that have accumulated pools of water and dung must be cleaned out and all leaking water troughs must be repaired by Monday 31 October 2022.
 5. Muddy paddocks must be cleaned and scraped to prevent animals having to stand or lie in dirty conditions. Some of the paddocks with shelter did not have any animals as the ground was wet and muddy. This must be rectified by no later than Monday 31 October 2022.
 6. The sheep confined in the paddocks have no access to any form of shade or shelter. This must be rectified by no later than 11 November 2022.

 - **Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.**
 - **Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.**
