On the 1st of December 2021 the West Coast SPCA in Vredenburg received a complaint about someone who brought his dog to the Wesland Animal Hospital to be checked out. The dog tested positive for Distemper, a highly contagious dog disease. The owner refused to let the dog be put to sleep and took the dog home. I phoned Wesland Animal Hospital and spoke with the complainant, Margaretha and she told me that the incident happened on Monday and that they want nothing to do with the whole thing because Dr Marlize, the owner, does not know that Margaretha contacted the SPCA. I called my Manager, Louise van Zyl, and we decided that I should obtain a warrant to go check if the dog is still alive. I was successful in obtaining a warrant and I then went with SAPS to the address of Mrt Kanov. On arrival, I was met by the owner of the house, Mr Kanov is a tenant on her property. I introduces myself and asked the owner about the dog in question. The owner Mrs Denise, let me on the property where I observed 1X black & white Pitbull X at the back of the yard. Denise told me that Mr Kanov's dog died the Monday afternoon. I told her that the dog tested positive for Distemper and that she should monitor her dog. I left my number for in case something happens. I will re-check to monitor the Pitbull X on the property. Water and shelter was observed for the Pitbull and his body condition is acceptable. I have attached the affidavit for warrant and the warrant to this case.
