Water, shelter and food observed. When I arrived at the Smallholding there was no people I managed to ask some neighbours at the Chicken abattoir and they gave me the owner's contact details and I phoned him.
He came and I explained to him the reason of my visit. I observed two Downers, a mare Chestnut and a Bay Stallion.
He told me that the horses were abandoned and he was trying to help. I explained to him that he was in custody and in control of the horses so it's his responsibility to look after the horses. Two members of SAPS came and Jeffrey also came.
I informed Mr Vergil about Section 5 of the animal Protection Act and he agreed that we can put down both Downers.
I did put down the 2 Horses with the help of Jeffrey.
There are 2 Horses that are thin, out of the remaining Horses. It is a Stallion Bay and a mare Chestnut. I issued a warning advising the owner to improve the body condition of the horses.
Will re-check in three weeks.

Virgil, the owner of the horses, was at the small holding on my arrival, he was busy feeding the horses.
I observed 3X mares and 1X stallion. In the food bowls I observed lucern and Oathay.
The horses has put on some weight and none of them were lying or showing signs of being sick. Fresh water is also available. I will do a re-check in 2 weeks time.
Being Investigated Thu 21-Apr-22 Re-Check Jameson October
The gate to the farm was closed. I called Virgil, but his phone went straight to voice mail. I could not see the horses, because from where I was it's to far.
