General Report Comments: I attended this case on the 16th of August 2022 and I could observe that the leg was badly injured and the ostrich needed to be put down. The SPCA tried to get a marksman or a Vet who can shoot or dart the ostrich without any luck. Some competent marksman refused to put down the ostrich as they were scared of the backlash from the Yzerfontain community. Dr Rust from Vredenburg DiereKlinik agreed to dart the ostrich on the 17th of August 2022. I went back to Yzerfontain accompanied by Inspectorate Manager Louise Van Zyl and we looked for the injured ostrich for one and half hours. The ostrich was lying on the ground between thick bushes. Dr Rust came after 10:00 am and he darted the ostrich. We then use euthepent to PTS the ostrich and left Yzerfontain after 12:00. The admission number for the ostrich is C 11394
