Upon closer inspection I saw that the cows leg has been injured. I saw the shepherd in the distance and went to him,he could not understand a word I was saying. I phoned my manager to contact law enforcement officer Isaac because he works with the small farmers and knows all the owners. We got hold of the owner Eric and explained to him the seriousness of the situation. I used SECTION 5 of the ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT to humanely euthanize the cow to put it out of its suffering. I issued Eric with a warning for not seeking medical attention for the cow and therefore let the cow suffer unnecessary . The other cows are in acceptable conditions. Will do a recheck.
