General Report Comments: When I arrived I saw the dog tied to a chain at the back without a collar.
The chain is about 3 meter long. Water, food and shelter observed.
The dog's body condition is fair and acceptable. ammaar told me that he want to breed with the dog, Max, and he is looking for a Boerboel female to breed with.
I educated on the chance of his dog getting prostate cancer if he is not sterilized. Ammaar then decided to have the dog sterilized and I phoned Inspectorate Manager Louise Van Zyl to ask Ally if they can sterilize the dog as they are at the SPCA kennels and I was told to bring the dog and R 600 cash for the sterilization. I brought the dog and he was sterilized.
The dog was vaccinated and I took 3 Triworm deworming tablets and gave them to the owner to give the dog the following day.
Will re-check in 7 days.
