General Report Comments: Myself and Inspector Chiwawa were granted access to the farm by the manager David Afrikaner . The male Alpacas were roaming freely on the farm. There were also 4 ponies and 3 sheep with the male alpacas. The male alpacas were in a fair condition and they were all sheared. There were no grazing but there were Oathay and Supplementary feed available to all. The ponies and sheep were in a good condition. There were water and shelter available to all. Mr Afrikaner then proceeded to take us to the camp where the females and the crias were kept. They were busy feeding them with Oathay and supplementary feed. Females were sheared but not the crias. There were also shelter and water available. All were in an acceptable condition. Mr Afrikaner advised me that the farm makes us of Bergzicht Animal Hospital in Malmesbury . I confirmed with Dr Andries from Bergzicht Animal Hospital 022 482 2399 and that they do go out to the farm last visit was in November 2022. I only observed 1 kitten that was in a good condition. There are chickens, turkeys, ostriches and 3 dogs on the property all in a good condition with no welfare concerns.
