Are cows handled calmly and quietly? No handling required, cows automatically walk through run and to milk ring.

Are hooves overgrown? No overgrown hooves were observed during the inspection.

Number of cows in milk production: 60 cows per milking ring - there are 2 rings - 360 cows per hour.

How often are cows milked? Cows are milked 3 times a day 7 days a week.

Are udders / teats cleaned? Yes Describe method: Staff manually apply blue substance and then a scrub.

Is milking procedure well monitored? Yes - 2 staff monitor cows entering ring, 3 staff clean udders, 3 staff monitor off loading.

Is milking of all quarters thorough? Yes - each udder has a milking pump placed on it.

Type of equipment used: Automatic Rotary Milking System Is equipment clean and well maintained? Yes

Are nipples well maintained? Yes - milk pumps. Floor non-slip: Yes - textured grating.

Condition of animals: Fair condition.

Condition of bulls: Fair - calves. No adults. Facilities: Moveable calf pens. Shelter: Zink roof & sides.
