You are hereby warned that:

In light of an inspection conducted on the 22nd of October 2024, the following concerns were observed and must be addressed and rectified **within 4 days**:

1. Provide veterinary treatment and/or recent, updated veterinary reports for the following dogs declaring them fit for duty:
 - a. B11 - "RAKA" (Boerboel, Male, Adult) appears to have callousness (large bulgy lumps) on his front paws, left front paw is more affected.
 - b. "ZEUS" (Rottweiler, Male, Adult) is obese (BCS 5/5).
 - c. D7 - "ZAXA" (GSD, Adult) appears to have hip dysplasia, or a possible underlying hip condition.
 - d. D2 - "ACE" – (GSD, Male, Adult) appears to have hip dysplasia, or a possible underlying hip condition.
2. An updated plan, or proof of euthanasia regarding "Bennie" (Rottweiler, Male, Adult) is required. As Bennie is underweight, and not working. As advised, you can consult with your veterinarian regarding appropriate sedatives to assist with the handling of Bennie.
3. Several kennels were observed with either broken sleeping boards, or no sleeping boards. A thorough check must be done throughout all the kennels to ensure that all the kennels have a sleeping board inside, and that the boards are in good repair.
4. More fly traps, or alternative fly control measures must be implemented at Kennel Block "B" and "E".
5. Half Check / Martingale Collars are to be removed from the dogs when they are placed inside the kennels. Alternative identification methods must be explored, as leaving these collars on can cause unnecessary injury and/or suffering to the dog/s.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act No 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 and / or Performing Animals Protection Act No 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
