On the 8th of November 2024 I was presented with this animal that was confiscated, the animal comes from Swartland SPCA and transferred to our facility due to insufficient space.

EXAMINATION FINDINGS

- **Description** of the condition:

Presented with Right front limb intermittent weight bearing lameness, no visible open wounds.

Animal was started on anti-inflammatory and pain management in which we have seen marked improvement, on this date there is only a mild limp seen

Radiographs revealed no obvious fractures.

In our care this puppy was dewormed, given tick and flea treatment.

- **Duration** of the condition: Acute
- **Prognosis** – Good
- **Recommendation** –

That this animal is fed a good quality Puppy specific diet for 12 months to ensure healthy bone development, we recommend Hills Puppy food.

We advise follow up radiographs of the limb in 2 weeks

COMMENTS

This animal should have received prompt veterinary intervention when injury was first noticed by owner, animal was instead left in pain.
