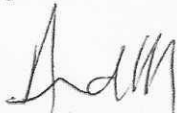
I, Dr Anel van der Merwe, have examined the 8 dogs and 5 puppies (M01/24) on 26/11/2024.

The mother and pups were in a relatively good condition compared to the other dogs.

The other adult dogs had mange ranging from mild-moderate to severe chronic mange with secondary bacterial skin infections that also severely affected their vision. Those dogs with mostly mild-moderate mange can be treated with Nexguard and/or weekly dipping. This is a contagious condition, and they should be kept separately from other dogs.

The dogs with impaired vision and severe mange with secondary bacterial infections would need anti-inflammatories as well as antibiotics, fluid therapy etc. They will need intensive treatment to treat the mange and secondary infected skin. This will be labour intensive and costly and therefore I would recommend that they should rather be euthanised.
