Dear Natasha,

We have provided your complaint to the Swartland and West Coast SPCA for their investigation.

You were informed of this on 03 December 2024. See attached emails.

We have also taken note of the defamatory remarks made on Facebook about the NSPCA and the SPCA and wish to advise as follows:

1. You acted alone and willingly when you unlawfully removed the dogs from the owners property;
2. You took over 2 weeks to provide an address for where the "compromised" dogs were, conveniently left out of your defamatory post;
3. The Swartland and West Coast SPCA is not a tool for you to then circumvent the laws you have broken;
4. This is pattern of categorical untruths shared on social media to generate an income for you at the expense of the animals, this is not the first time you have neglected to provide details and an address of animal cruelty to the SPCA; and
5. As we are advised, the Swartland and West Coast SPCA did not inform the owner to go to the police, it was the community leader.

We request you rectify the inconsistencies and be truthful on social media as to this complaint.
