This is not a kennel structure. Animals are roaming freely. The property was exceptionally clean, no bad smell was picked up.

This appears to be a dispute of some sort. Leandi also advises that she will be moving from the premises within the next month due to issues with the landlord (I suspect the landlord is the complainant).

She manages the animals well, and they are very obedient toward her, however the dogs do not allow strangers to enter and it was extremely difficult for me to enter the property due to the dogs aggressive nature. Leandi had to place majority of the dogs inside the house for me to do a yard check and I had to look through the windows to see inside the house. The dogs were then let loose for me to visually inspect them. I picked a few out for closer observation, which Leandi then brought to me to physically inspect.

The one dog, Jack Russell x, named Ruby was allegedly 3 months ago at AWS Phillip with a broken leg, the leg was pinned etc. It appears as if the break did not heal well. Ruby did not place pressure on the leg and keeps it lifted. There was no swelling or heat though. I advised Leandi to have Ruby taken back to the veterinarian just to check and make sure all are in order. I suspect the dog became used to the leg being kept in this position for long, and that the leg might have not attached well and now it is a mental block causing the dog to keep the leg in the air.

Leandi advised she will make arrangements for the dog to be taken during the week and provide me with feedback.

Adoption rate is currently slow.

This is a no kill organisation

Was action taken? Recommendations regarding hand and shoe sole F10 spray.

Follow-up action? To follow up on Ruby, and conduct routine inspection after Leandi moved to a new property.
