Inspection Details:

Findings:

1. Property Overview:
 - There are two dogs on the property, separated by a gate, both roaming freely.
2. White Male Dog:
 - Living Area: The living area for the white male dog was found to be unclean and in need of immediate attention.
 - Water: There was no potable water available for the white male dog.
3. Light Female Dog:

- Health Condition: The light female dog has a noticeable large growth at her back between her legs, which requires veterinary attention.
 - Living Area: Similar to the male dog, the living area for the female dog was also found to be unclean.
4. Behavioral Observation:
- The dogs barked upon our arrival, which then subsided—a normal behavior for dogs. However, it remains unclear if barking is an issue during other times of the day.
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Actions Taken:

- Issued Warning: A warning (Reference: W4641) was issued to the owner with the following directives:
 1. Veterinary Care: The female dog must be provided with veterinary care within 4 days.
 2. Living Area Cleanliness: The living areas for both dogs must be cleaned within 24 hours.
 3. Water Supply: Potable water must be made available to both dogs at all times.
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Follow-Up:

- A follow-up inspection will be conducted to ensure compliance with the issued warning and to reassess the conditions of the dogs and their living areas.

Note:

- Addressing the living conditions and providing veterinary care are the immediate concerns. However, the barking problem may require further observation and action from Law Enforcement if it persists.
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Conclusion:

Immediate action is required by the property owner at 10 Andros Street to improve the living conditions and health of the dogs. Compliance with the issued warning will be monitored, and further measures will be taken if necessary.
