According to Mr. Khan, the above address is where his children are currently residing.

Background:

Mr. Khan is currently a resident in Sandy Point, St Helena Bay.
The West Coast SPCA assisted Law Enforcement with a joint inspection at Mr Khan's property regarding parrots he kept in his garage that allegedly make a lot of noise.

6x African Grey Breeding Pairs and 1x Moluccan Eclectus Breeding Pair was observed being kept in temporary breeding cages (1200 x 600 x 800).

The cages were inadequate for permanent housing, regardless of breeding purposes. A few African Greys were observed with feather loss and the Eclectus had an old fractured wing (Dr. Coetzee De Beer) previously seen to these birds and provided treatment.

Mr Khan advised us that he will be relocating the birds to Cape Town , due to the amount of complaints, over the past weekend, and also advised that the birds will kept in aviaries.

Mr. Khan has a rather hostile attitude, and tends to revert to the "Apartheid regime" and has called me a few times racist towards him, and might be difficult in granting access. Mr. Khan i
