Comments:	Upon my arrival, I was met by Ettiene, the owner and an elderly woman whom I was told is his mother. The elderly woman was immediately aggressive towards me and indicated I must go do my work elsewhere and focus on the dog walking in the streets. I tried to explain to her the mandate of the SPCA vs Law Enforcement but she did not want to understand and walked off. I further continued speaking with Ettiene and we discussed how and where to setup the runner. The runner will run down on the side of the house for about 25m. He will make the attaching chain shorter, to prevent the dog from possibly jumping the fence. He asked what will happen if he does not do this within 7 days and I explained to him that the time granted is reasonable and that I am assisting him with the wire, and he possibly not complying will give me the indication that he does not want to improve the dog's welfare and then intentionally keeping the dog in a manner which is likely to cause unnecessary suffering due to the restricted space . He seem to understand and gave me the indication that the runner will be installed within the given time frame. I will follow up next week.
