1x cow was down, laying on her side. Owner is Mandla. According to Vusi the cow is on treatment and he confirmed this with the owner as well. (I followed up on the cow every day for 3 days where the cow was standing and grazing and appeared to have recovered).

2.

Alot of plastic is scattered around the property, We made a recommendation for a skip to be placed close by whereby the people can clean and discard of any plastic accordingly.

General: no contraventions in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 observed. It appears as if the owners are taking responsibility for their animals and are caring well for them.
