General Report Comments: Routine check conducted regarding the small farmers in the area.
The resident farmers are still in compliance, majority of the animals were free roaming outside in the designated veld. Few animals were seen in the enclosures/camps, those observed had water, shelter and a clean living area and the animals also appeared to be in good condition.

CONCERN:

As I was driving, I observed a new structure with pigs kept inside.
GPS coordination: -32.9266531, 18.0354198

8x pigs were observed in total. There are 3x enclosures. The one enclosure was empty, 1 had 6x 4month old piglets inside and 1 had 2x 4 month old piglets inside. The shelter was broken as the zinc seemed to have broken off. The enclosure with the 2 piglets had no shelter.

The owner was not present, and I could not discuss the concerns with him/her.

I proceeded to issue a warning (W4642) stating:

1. Provide the pigs with adequate shelter within 5 days as the zincs are broken and one camp has no shelter.

I attached the warning to a pole.
