General Report Comments: I arrived at the farm and was accompanied by Senior Official Isaac Sifiniza from law enforcement . A person that lives there named Wynand told us us that the cattle belongs to Buks van Wyk . He is living there since 2017 and the cattle has also been there since then. Wynand said that he was not aware of any fencing that the cattle is damaging. I told him about the complaint that we received and that the cattle does not have food and water. He took us to the cattle and I observed +- 180 Cattle. They were all in acceptable condition. He took us to the water trough and it was connected to a borehole and that means they have water constantly. The crip works with a ball valve and fills up automatically when the water level get low. He also showed us the feed trouhs and there was food available. I then contacted the complainant Alida Buckle and told her that the cattle was in a good condition and had food and water available and that it seems the problem that she is describing is the breaking of the border fence which the SPCA cannot assist with . Mrs Buckle said that she understands and asked me if I can find out who the owner of the land is so that they can try and get to an agreement to fix the fencing properly. Mr Sifiniza said from LE knows the owner of the cattle and said that he will find out who the owner of the land is. Mrs Buckle said that she understands that the SPCA cannot assist with the fencing problem and also said that the cattle is in a good condition. NFA until further notice.
