General Report Comments: Upon arrival, no one appeared to be home, however the property does not have a gate and I can see the animal from the entrance.

I observed 2x dogs, same as on my previous inspection. The owner has complied by placing the Snauzer on a running chain. The running chain is approximately 20m long with an attaching 2m light chain. The chain around the neck has been placed inside a bicycle tube as well.

Today I observed the other dog, brown, old being tethered to his kennel. I assume is is because no one is home as they previously mentioned that he follows them when they leave. The rope is about 4m long, he has access to watet, a large kennel and clean living area.

Both dogs are still underweight and I will monitor their weight over the next 4 weeks to see if the pick up, based on being dewormed recently and having more roaming space.

The owner has complied with the warning issued.
