General Report Comments: Acces to the property was provided telephonically by the farm owner. Ms. Smit.

As you drive onto the farm the first batch of houses are directly on your left. White walls with green roofs.

First animal owner:

Johanna Swarts

3x dogs (dog 1: Lady, Xbreed, Female, Black/Tan, Adult; dog 2: no name, xbreed, female, Black/Tan, 5months; no name, xbreed, female, black/tan, 5months, appears to have a skin condition)

These dogs were free roaming. The moment Ms Swarts saw me she advised that she is glad I am there and asked if she can surrendered the 3x dogs. I agreed and loaded the dogs.

She does not have any other animals

Second animal owner:

Ms. Grey

1x dog (Whiskey, Terrier x, Male, unsterilised, white, adult)

1x cat (white/tabby, 7months, male) - I only briefly saw the cat as the cat ran away (free roaming)

Whisky is free roaming, has a kennel but allegedly sleeps inside the house at night. He had water and a clean living area. No APA contaventions were observed regarsing Whiskey.

Third animal owner:

Colin Simon

1x dog (Pitbull, Black/White, Male, Unsterilised, Adult, aggressive)

The dog is confined inside an enclosure of about 3m x 2m and is on a static chain inside the enclosure, the chain is approximately 2m long. The dog does not have a collar and has the chain fixed around his neck. The dog appears to be in good condition, however the appears to display stereotypical behavior as a result of the current confined method. The dog had a kennel, clean living environment and water. The dog is confined due to him being human and animal aggressive and with this being a farm, they are afraid he will attack the farm animals.

A warning (W5204) was issued to enlarge the enclosure (5m x 5m) there is space to do this. To fix the pin of the chain in the middle of the enclosure providing the dog a 360 degree rotation, as this will provide the dog with more roaming space. Also to place the chain around the neck inside a hosepine or bicycle tube, as the chain can cause shaving. The owner was not present, however a visitor named Chaneal signed and accepted the warning on behalf of the owner.

Fourth animal owner:

To get to these animals, you drive through the large steel gate and follow the gravel road up to the workshop, on the left of the workshop is a white workshop with a red roof.

Patricia also asked is she could surrender all the dogs, which I agreed to and loaded them.
