General Report Comments: As I was about to leave the area, I observed the people living at the first house now has a dog. It is a juvenile pitbull x, black. I can see the sex.

No one appeared to be home and I could not address the concerns in person with the owner.

The dog is chained to a pole next to the kennel. The chain is approximately 2m long. The kennel is for a puppy and the dog is evidently too large now to fit inside the kennel.

The property is well fenced, causing me to question the reason for chaining.

I proceeded to issue a warning (W5216) that a larger kennel must be provided and that the dog must either roam free inside the property, and only if the dog jumps the fence they can place the dog on a running chain.

A running chain leaflet was also provided.

I attached the warning to the gate post.
