General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by Kattie. The property and animal owner.

The kennel has not yet been brought over, as the kennel is apparently heavy and the sons must bring it over. Kattie advised that the kennel will be brought over today.

I said to the owner that I will come by tomorrow morning again and the kennel must then be provided.

There is an afdak section in front of the main door which does provide some protection against the weather elements, but not all. The dog apparently sleeps inside the house at night to keep the owner safe, as someone broke into her house recently.

The dog is currently on a running chain of approximately 7m, with an attaching lead of 2.5m. The area is clean and the dog has water. The dog is in good condition, with no veterinary and/or health concerns observed.

I will come past tomorrow morning, to check if the kennel is here.

As I was about to leave it began to rain, and I saw Kattie run to fetch the kennel. She and her sister were struggling with the kennel and I asked if I could help by loading the kennel in the bakkie and bringing it around. We did this and with the help of a man walking by we loaded and offloaded the kennel.

The kennel is placed under the afdak to provide protection.

This case can now be closed as there are no further APA contraventions.
