General Report Comments: As i was driving in the area I saw the dog chained to the fence. The property is not well fenced, hence the dog is likely on a chain.

As I approached the dog, the dog was laying down, and the dog seemed underweight. I called the dog and the dog stood up where I then observed the dog to be emaciated as the rib cage, hip bones and spine are clearly visible.

The dog is confined on a staric chain of approximately 2.5m long, attached to the fence. The dog had access to a large kennel which provides the dog with adequate shelter. The dog also had access to water. And the living area was clean and hygienic.

During my tine outside the property no one responded to my calls and I can only assume that no one is home.

I proceeded to issue a warning (W5209) insteucting the owner to:

1. Take the dog for veterinary assesement within 48 hrs.
2. Place the dog on a running chain within 48hrs.
3. Advised that they can also surrender the dog.
