General Report Comments: Upon arrival, the gate was opened and I drove in. 3x young children approached me and claimed their parents are at work.

I could see the dog from the gate. The dog is 9n a long static chain, approximately 10m. It is a light chain and the dog has a suitbale collar.

The owner has provided the dog with an old wheelie bin (dustbin) for shelter, however, this has been placed as is on the sand. The area where the dog also roams is coverws with white rocks that can cause injuriea or the chain to become stuck.

I proceeded to issue a Final Warning (W5246) stating:

1. All the rocks must be cleared from the dpgs roaming area.
2. If the dustbin is to be used permanently, the dustbin must be lifted from the ground, placed on a pallet and have shade neet or a sheet on top to be a buffer from heavy heat , if not a suitable dog kennel must be provided.

I will follow up in 5 days to verify compliance.
