General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met by Nosisa. Her mother is apparently the dogs owner, but she works in Cape Town and onky comes home over weekends. However, Nosisa claimed that she is also the owner as she is the primary care giver of the dogs.

Dog 1: kept on a short static chain at the main entrance of the property. The chain is approximately 1.5m long.

Dog 2: kept on a short static chain in the right corner of the property. The chain is approximately 1.2m long and tangled.

Dog 3: kept on a short static chain on the right hand side of the property. The chain is attached to a tree. The chain is approximately 2.2m long.

Dog 4: is kept on a short static chain on the far right back corner of the property. The chain is approximately 1.8m long.

I asked Nosisa why the dogs are on chains, as the SPCA previously educated them regarding this method of chaining. Nosisa advised that her mother decided to chain the dogs like this, she does not know the full reason, but can assume it is because the dogs are all aggressive and the property is not well fenced with a low boundary fence as well.

I proceeded to issue a warning (W5226) stating:

1. The dogs must be placed on running chains, refer to the attached running chain leaflet.
 2. It is recommended that they surrender 2x dogs.
- 7 days is given for compliance.

Nosisa signed and accepted the Warning and advised that she will call me on Monday to discuss the way forward as she will discuss with her mother to surrender 2 x dogs.

If she does not call me on Monday, I will call her and find out.
