I could see the dog from the property gate, and saw the dog is confined on a short static chain of approximately 1.5m long.

I proceeded to issue a warning (W5227) stating:

1. The current method of confined is unacceptable, as the dog's movement is restricted.
2. Place the dog on a running chain, refer to leaflet for guidance.

I explained everything to Vivian, who understood and guaranteed that she will give the warning to her son, the owner.
