General Report Comments: Upon my arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner, Mr May. I asked him to show me the puppy he had at the mobile clinic. He went and fetch a very weak boerboel puppy that appeared to be showing Parvo symptoms.

The owner advised that he had the puppy at Malmesbury animal clinic, however he could not pay the consultation fee, hence he went to the mobile clinic hoping he could obtain treatment for his dog at a reduced cost. The mobile clinic does not provide treatment and the only option the owner was given was humane euthanasia, which he did not want at that stage.

I advised the owner that the puppy is in a severe compromised state and that in my experience his puppy is actually busy dying, as the dog was weak, dehydrated, had pale gums and was lethargic. The owner then requested for the puppy to be humanely euthanised. I agreed and loaded the puppy in my vehicle. The owner then also gave me another dog (JR x Foxterrier) as surrender, as the dog was in direct contact with the puppy and he can't afford treatment for this dog.

Both dogs were admitted:
ADM: D7332, D7333

The underweight boerboel was apparently poisoned a few weeks ago, this is his son's dog, and the dog was taken to Malmesbury Animal Clinic for treatment. According to Mr May, the dog has slowly begun to pick up weight again.

No concerns were observed regarding the pitbull.

I did not issue the owner with a warning as the owner tried to render medical treatment and was seeking out for assistance.

I will do a routine check on the Boerboel in 3 weeks time to see if he has picked up weight.
