General Report Comments: Upon arrival, it appeared as if no one was home as there was no response to my presense.

I saw the dog from looking over the property wall which is low, 1.4m. And the entrances are semi blocked with pallets.

The dog is kept on right side of the property on a short static chain which is fixes to a pole. The chain is approximately 1.7m long. The dog also has a raw chain around his neck. The dog has access to 2x boles next to the wall, one filled with water, the other filled with pap. The dog appears to be in fair condition.

I issued a final warning (W4610), as NTC's have already been issued, stating:

1. The manner in which the dog is chained is unacceptable as the dog movement is restricted.
2. Refer to attached runner leaflet and install a runner within 5 days.
3. To contact me to discuss these concerns.

I attached the warning on the window next to the main door.
