Upon closer inspection I saw that the dog has a wound on his neck due to chaining him without a collar. Camennita told me that she has been treating the wound with antiseptic wound ointment. I could see that the wound was starting to get dry and is healing. I told Camennita that she must get some of that purple wound spray as well because that wound spray keeps the flies away. I issued a warning to remove the dog from the chain, and they immediately did. I also told Camennita that if the dog must be chained he must always have a collar around his neck. Will follow up.
