General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by Fanesco Solomons, the owner.

Dog 1: Black /tan - Ruby, was free roaming inside the property. Owner chains Ruby when they are not home as Ruby jumps the fence and attacks people walking in the road. Ruby is rather aggressive and also tried to attack me while I was doing my inspection. Ruby has a wooden dog kennel, access to water and a clean living area. When Ruby is chained, she is chained to a 3m light chain with a suitable collar. Ruby is slightly underweight. Owner did deworm the dogs over the weekend. Will monitor weight gain.

Dog 2: white/brown - Lana was seen chained to her kennel. The chain is approximately 3m long. The dog had a raw chain as a collar, owner will replace the collar in the week. His friend has one for him. Lana has a large wooden kennel, access to water and a fairly clean living area. Lana is also slightly underweight, and was also dewormed over the past weekend. Lana appears to have an eye irritation, this is highly likely due to the sandy surface and dust. Owner asked for advice regarding eye drops, I advised him to enquire from Saldanha Animal Hospital (he left when I left to go buy). The eyes are not bad, they just need a good flush and some lubricating drops. He will apply the eye drops and monitor for a week, if not better he will take her to the vet. I also advised the owner to move Lana to the other side of the property as the boundary wall will provide additional protection from the wind blowing sand/dust in her eyes.

The owner was very forthcoming and cooperative. He acknowledged receipt of FO Mathabela's NTC and advised that he will either have the runners installed, or install the 360 swivel chain by next week. He and his friend will be setting up the runners within the next few days.

I will follow up next week and verify progress.
