General Report Comments: EXECUTION OF WARRANT
ACCOMPANIED BY SALDANHA SAPS SGT DAVIDS AND HIS TEAM.

Upon arrival, I was in full uniform and my SPCA branded vehicle, I entered the property as the property does not have a fence or gate.

I observed the same dog, confined and kept in the same manner as previously seen. The dog was on a short static chain of approximately 1.2m long. Had water, and a makeshift kennel. The dog is in an emaciated condition and had raw sores on her neck as well from the chain being used as a collar.

The owner immediately approached me and was verbally aggressive as to the fact that I am here to take the dog. I explained to her in a calm manner that she was given an opportunity to uplift the welfare but she did not want to, hence I obtained a warrant to seize the dog. I gave her the warrant and proceeded to the dog. I took the dog and loaded the dog into my SPCA vehicle.

Issued the owner with a seizure notice.

The dog was then taken to Vredenburg Diereklíníek and assessed by Dr. JACOBS.

DOG 2.

I did not seize the initial dog on the property, as this dog belongs to another person. Zane Leigh. He has improved the living area of the dog. He has changed the chain to no tangle on the rope. I advised him to use a hosepipe around the chain as this will also make the chain running smoother on the runner. The dog had water and a kennel. The dog is also in good condition. The only concern is a collar. He tried the hosepipe collar but the dog manages to get the collar off. I advised him that he has till Monday to make an alternative plan for a collar as the dog can't have a chain for a collar.

I will follow up on this dog Monday, to ensure compliance.
