General Report Comments: Upon arrival, no one appeared to be home as there was no response to my presence.

I observed the dog being placed on a very long light chain with 360 degree movement space. The chain is approximately 10m long. The dog have been fitted with a collar, however, the chain is still around the neck and not placed on the collar.

A makeshift kennel has been provided but it faces the sun directly, is rather small and has panels missing which provided inadequate protection against the weather elements.

If the owner contacts me regarding a kennel, I will discuss with my manager, Insp Van Zyl about donating a kennel to tjos property.

I issued a warning (W4621) stating:

1. Provide the dog with adequate protection against the weather elements. Either fix the kennel or get a new one;
2. The chain must be attached to the collar and not be raw around the dog's neck.
