The rope is approximately 1.5m long, and is also tied around the dog's neck. The dog did not have water, as the bowl was finished. There is also no adequate shelter, even though there is a shaded net cover it will not provide the dog against all the elements.

No one appeared to be home, as there was no response to my presence.

I issued a warning (W4624)

1. Provide the dog with water at all times
2. Provide the dog with adequate shelter
3. Place the dog on a runner or allow the dog to free roam.
