General Report Comments: Upon arrival, the owner was not home, however his father in law, Kobus, came to me and granted me access to the property.

I saw the same dog kept in the same condition as during TI Mathabela's inspection.

The dog is chained in front of the front door. The chain is approximately 1.5m long. The dog has a raw chain around his neck.

I explained to Kobus what is expected and he immediately began to implement a runner. He also went to his home and fetched a leather collar to replace the raw chain.

He advised that all will be done by Monday.

I issued a warning (W4639) stating

1. The manner in which the dog is chained is unacceptable, the dog must be placed on a runner, I.
2. Refer to attached leaflet

3 days were granted to comply
