General Report Comments: The complainant called again to say that the owner has chained the female pitbull because she keeps getting out. On arrival Keanen was on the property, who is the owner of the dogs son. I saw the brown and white female pitbull tied on the steep with a leash. Keane told me that his father tied Milo because she keeps getting out, and that law enforcement has issued them with a fine because of the dog that keeps getting out. I told Keanen that I understand that the dog needs to be kept safe from causing trouble, but the way Milo are being tied is not adequate. Milo and her puppies body conditions is acceptable and they do have water, food and shelter available. I explained to Keanen that his father must install a running chain so that Milo can have more space to move around. I issued a warning to install a running chain. Will follow up within 7x days.
