I issued another warning to provide the dog with adequate shelter,put the dog on a running chain or to extend his chain and to also provide the dog with a collar. The owner of the pitbull were not there and I explained to the young boy who also lives on this property the seriousness of the situation and that he must tell the owner of the dog that the dog will be removed if the second warning is not adhered too. Will follow up.
