General Report Comments: Myself and trainee inspector Chiwawa attended the Qurbani site. 33 Bulls were slaughtered. Only Cattle. There were no transport as the cattle are all from the farm Waylands. All Animals were handled humanely and no animals were tied up. There were no overcrowding of animals, no downers, no injuries. The cattle that got slaughtered could not be seen by the cattle waiting in the holding pens. The farmers workers herded the cattle from the farm pastures to the holding pens at the slaughtering site. They did not use any sticks or prodders at all. All cattle were stunned with a captive bolt before slaughter. 1 to 2 strokes used as this was addressed with the 2023 Qurbani. This farmer Mr Duckitt is very strict and complies with everything that the SPCA request. If the people that bought cattle to slaughter on the day does not comply to his instructions then he refunds them and tells them that they cannot slaughter on his farm. There were no contraventions of the APA. NFA
