As I was at the property I observed the dogs tails wagging for a person standing in the road, I asked the person (Aluwe) if he knows the owner and he said yes, they are friends. I asked If he knows why the 1x dog is chained, and he said he is not sure. I asked Aluwe when he will see the owner again and he said this afternoon, but he has access to his house. I asked Aluwe if he will give the warning to the owner, and he agreed.

Warning issued:

1. The current method of chaining seems unnecessary as the dog was previously observed free roaming inside the property.
2. The dog may only be placed on a runner, if necessary.
