Straight away I could see that these pigs are hungry because they came running to the front thinking I'm bringing food. The pigs are a bit underweight and no food was observed for them. The owner of the pigs was not there. Water and shelter is available. I issued a warning W5065 to provide the pigs with adequate food within 7x days. Will follow up.
