I called the boy called Caleb and asked him if his parents are at home and he said no, I asked him why the dog is chained and he told me that they can't let the dog loose because their property is not fully fenced. I walked with the boy and saw 1x brown and white pitbull x male on a +- 2meter long static chain with a collar. The dog called Max is very friendly and still young. Water, food and shelter is available and his body condition is acceptable. I issued warning W5073 to install a runner or to extend the dogs chain. Will follow up.
