General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner, Jamin September.

I asked to see his dogs and he gave a whistle and the dogs came running to him from the veld. The dogs have a very large area to roam as there is no fence and a very large veld at the back of the property.

I observed 2x dogs. The the female dog named Ghost, appeared to be slightly underweight but was walking strange with her hind quarters, I asked Jamin what is wrong and he advised that she was knocked by a car last week but stood up and run home. He did not make much of it as he did not see blood or broken bones, according to Jamin it has only now been for the last 2 days that the dog has begun to walk differently. I advised Jamin the he will either have to seek veterinary treatment for the dog, or he can surrender the dog for humane euthanasia. Jamin agreed to sign the dog over.

The other dog is in good condition, with a BCS 3/5. The dogs stay indoors with Jamin and even when he is not home he has a low window open where the dog jumps in and out as needed. The dog has water and no veterinary or health concerns were observed regarding the remaining dog. The dog was dewormed, dipped and received the annual Rabies inoculation 1 week ago when the mobile clinic was in the area.

I issued the owner with a warning for future reference:
1. When you have an animal in your care that is in need of veterinary treatment, such treatment must be provided without delay.

I will close this case, as there are no further APA contraventions.
