General Report Comments: Upon arrival, the owner was not present as he is apparently still in Atlantis .

I met with the daughter. I saw the dog has lot weight again, as his ribcage, spine and hip bones were present. I asked the daughter to show me the dog's food and she said that there is no food, as her father has not send money yet to them to buy food. I asked when did the dog last ate, and she advised yesterday during the day.

Anthore young womand came from the house and gave the dog some house food, pap with chicken bones and the dog gulped it up in a few seconds, indicating to me that the dog is starved currently.

The dog was also observed today to be kept on a short static chain, of approximately 1.5m. The daughter could not advise me as to the reason.

I called the owner, Ricardo, who was available on a number recived from his daughter- 0798350084

He said he cant comment about what is going on at his home as he is not there. I gave him the option to surrender the dog, but he did not want to and was being stubborn saying if I take his dog he will come and remove my children from me.

This owner is currently not taking responsibility for his dog, nor are the people he placed in charged during his absence and I am of the opinion this dog is currently being starved and likely suffering unnecessary.

I will apply for a warrant to remove this dog.
