The pitbull female is also underweight, I asked Alexander if they have food for the dog and he said yes. I expressed the welfare concerns around the dog and issued warning W5558 to provide the pitbull with a collar, to install a running chain, to get the dog dewormed and to provide the dog with puppy food. Will recheck.
