General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner.

I saw the dog in question chained in the back section of the yard. The dog's chain was twirled and the dog still had a chain for a collar. I asked the owner as to why he has not complied and he advised that he is struggling financially and does not have the means to install a runner, but that he has obtained a longer light chain in the interim. Regarding shelter, the dog currently has none and the owner placed the dog inside the house at night to have protection against the weather elements during the evening.

I assisted the owner by moving the dog to the shade and installing the longer chain, this chain is approximately 6m long. I gave the owner a collar and a swivel to prevent the chain from twirling.

I looked at the side of the house and saw alot of old zinc plates and poles. I advised the owner to use these materials to build shelter for the dog, he said he will have this done by Wednesday. I will return on Wednesday to ensure this is done.

The owner advised that he will still like to install a runner and that he will source material to install such.
