I saw the dog on a runner, the cable is approximately 10m long with an attaching 6m light chain. The dog has a material collar with an attaching swivel to prevent the chain from twirling. The owner managed to obtain an unused refused bin which he is using for shelter, and that provides adequate protection against the weather elements. He also placed a thick cushion inside for the dog to lie on.

The owner complied with the warning issued.

The dog's welfare has been uplifted.

I am satisfied with closing the case, as the owner complied and there are no APA contraventions observed.
