General Report Comments: I saw 1x black and white Husky x male tied on a 1,5 meter leash with a collar. I stopped and the owner Ronel Waterboer came out. I asked Ronel why the Husky is on a short leash and she told me it's because her property is not fully fenced and that the Husky x called Zeus has been bitten by a pitbull before. Water and shelter is available and Zeus body condition is acceptable. I told Ronel that I understand that Zeus needs to be tied for his own safety, but there is a better way to tie a dog if need to be tied and I explained to her how a running chain works. Ronel understood and told me that she will make sure that her husband installs the running chain. I issued warning W5589 to install a running chain for Zeus. Will follow up.
