General Report Comments: Accompanied by Trainee Insp Mathabela

Upon arrival, no one appeared to be home as there was no response to our presence.

We observed 1x dog tethered on a short rope at the far back of the property. The rope has twirled in such a way that the length was restricted to less than 500mm. The dog has a material collar and appears to be in good condition with no veterinary or health concerns observed.

I looked around the property and found rope which we used to extend the tether to at least 4m. We also filled up the dog's water bowl with water, as the water level was low.

We left a warning:
