General Report Comments: CORRECT ADDRESS: 25 LOOP STREET, LONG ACRES

Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner.

I shared the nature of the complaint with her and she accompanied me to the horse in question.

The horse is a grey, Boerperd x, gelding, 20yrs old. The horse is slightly underweight with a BCS 2/5. The horse however had diarrhoea, as faeces marks can be seen down his hind legs.

According to the owner this is a very difficult horse and she has the vet here monthly, he is also currently on Flunixin power for when he appears off.

I advised that based on my findings today I will advise the vet attend to the horse again. She had no issue with arranging this.

I asked if the horse is being ridden, she advised yes, but only by small children and only in a walk and a trot. I advised that they stop immediately and until a vet puts it in writing that the horse can be worked in a riding school, the horse is not to be used. She understood.

I asked who her vet is and she advised that it is Dr C from Weskus Veeartsnykonde. As I am aware that they rarely attend to matters asap, as an appointment has to be made with them first and that they only attend to yards on an appointment basis, I gave the owner the time to arrange for the vet to come out, and kept the weekend days in mind. The owner advised that she will have the vet out tomorrow, as she will even pay the extra cost. I was satisfied to hear this, but still advised the owner that I will be reasonable and grant her till Tuesday.

The horse was still active, eating drinking and moving around well, and being interactive. The droppings I saw in the paddock were all solid.
