General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was met and granted access to the property by the owner.

He took me to the back where the dog is kept. He advised last week when I left, that evening he opened the dog's mouth and saw a yellow pussy knob in the dog's gum. He pressed the knob and it burst open with alot of puss ozzing out. He apparently called the St Helena Bay Veterinary Clinic for advise and they informed him to flush the mouth with salt water and to press all the puss out, which he has done. He has been cleaning the mounth 3x day with salt water and the knob has not returned.

I opened the dog's mouth today and did not see any knob or experienced a bad smell, like last week. I could be that the dog had an absess rather than a rotting tooth, and the absess has been drained well now.

I was able to open the dog's mouth properly, look at all the tooth and I did not see any rotten teeth. The owner showed me where the knob was and there is no sign of a reoccurring absess.

It appear as if the matter resolved itself, with the assistance of the owner, and the owner consultanting with a veterinarian.

I did not observed any contraventions in terms of the APA during my inspection .

The owner advised if the knob reoccur that he wil.not hesitante to inform me and that he will then take the dog to the vet. But for now, I am not of the opinion that it is needed for the dog to be taken to the vet.
